Initiated by the Somerset House Studios community, The Artists' Fair is back for its second, expanded iteration, with an artist-led market and programme of panel talks, facilitating an informal space for artists and audiences to engage.

For The Artists' Fair, we encourage visitors to enter via Lancaster Place (between Waterloo Bridge and the Strand).

On arrival at Somerset House, you will see a gate and some lamps, here, you will be able to exit the public footpath.
Continue on to the entrance in the middle of the building.

There will be a member of staff here to welcome you. There are a small number of seats available here.
